We are delighted to announce our most recent academic results for the Matric Class of 2025.

We are reporting on both the NSC and the Cambridge results.

NSC examination highlights 2025 are as follows:

143 boys wrote the NSC examinations;

100% pass rate achieved;

98.6% Bachelors pass;

474 subject distinctions (3.31 per boy);

14% of all subject results were above 90%;

45% of all subject results were above 80%;

58 boys achieved an overall average of 80% and above (41% of the class);

16 boys achieved an overall average of 90% and above.

The top student was Grant Weich with an average of 95.3%, followed by Daniel van den Heever with 94.6%, and Noah Macnab with 94.4%.

9 distinctions were achieved by Jack Buckham, Noah Macnab, David Tripe and Daniel van den Heever.

8 distinctions were achieved by Zeno Benolich, Muhammad-Zayd Bhorey, Christopher Du Toit, Connor Fletcher, Massimiliano Hunt, David Lewis, Ben Myburgh, Samuel Stavely-Alexander, John van der Watt, Reece Van Wyk, Daniel von der Heyden and James Wilkin.

Cambridge A Level highlights 2025 are as follows:

9 boys wrote Cambridge International GCE A Level examinations, wherein they specialised in three subjects each.

100% pass rate achieved;

3 A*'s and 9 As were achieved which equates to 57% of all grades;

[An A* is the equivalent of 96%+ in the NSC, and an A is between 91% and 95%.]

The top three performers were: Matthew Walker, James Thunstrom and Matthew Griffin.

We are extremely proud of these results and congratulate every boy on his achievement. We thank all their teachers whose guidance and motivation, over all the years, made such a big difference.
