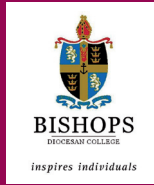

The group grew under the wise and supportive leadership of Karen Nelson during 2011, and we said a sad farewell to some of our regular prayer partners as they have moved across to the Prep; however, it is with joy that we meet this year under the new and willing leadership of Thandi Moyo. We pray for God's guiding hand as we undertake the responsibility of praying for the school this year. Our Pre-Prep Music Concert

was held towards the end of term early one morning in the Memorial Theatre, allowing parents to attend before heading off to work. The theatre was filled with excited boys and parents, and once again Desiré Swanich managed to allow each musician and the choir to perform and experience, for many, their first time on a stage in front of a large audience – and they did us all proud too! We hosted a number of functions towards the end of the year – one was a tea to thank our hard-working and supportive class reps; another was a tea and party to welcome our new 2012 Grade R's to the school, together with their parents. They were both extremely appreciative of the generosity of our parent body and we received a thank you card from Sharon expressing her thanks.
